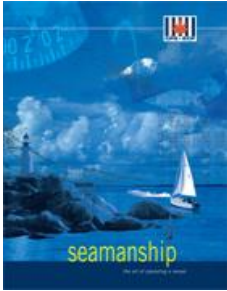


Seamanship Course

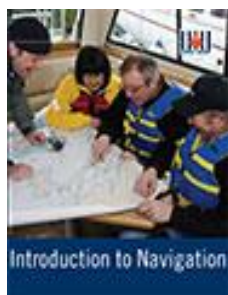
